

Idaho Employers and Educators, are you looking to create meaningful connections between the world of work and education?

The Educator Externship Program is a summer program that brings educators into the workplace of an Idaho employer for a 200-hour on-site work-based learning experience.

Educators gain awareness about in-demand careers, valuable industry experience, \$5,000, and have the opportunity to earn free professional development credit.

Employers are able to create awareness for their workforce needs within the education system, benefit from the work the educator provides, and develop a direct connection to the classroom.

Seeking employers and educators for summer 2023.

Employers

- Provide a challenging work opportunity that contributes to company operations while providing authentic workplace experiences
- Ensure educator sees broader career opportunities within the organization/industry and understands challenges of hiring and retaining employees
- Provide the necessary training and ongoing mentoring needed for the extern to be successful

Educators

- Be a certified Idaho K-12 public school teacher, college/ career advisor, or post-secondary educator working in an Idaho public school and planning to return following summer break
- Submit an application through the STEM AC and meet prospective employer(s) for interviews
- Be able to work 200 hours over the summer and meet performance expectations
- Share experiences with students, other educators and college and career advisors regionally



The Educator Externship Program is funded by Micron through a grant from the Idaho Workforce Development Council.

Employer and educator applications open January 2, 2023 and close to February 10, 2023.

Externs can work the 200 hours between June and August.
