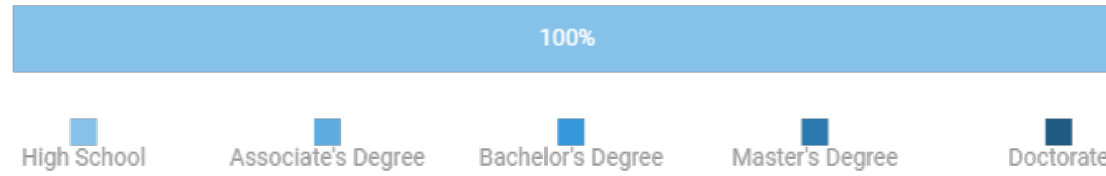

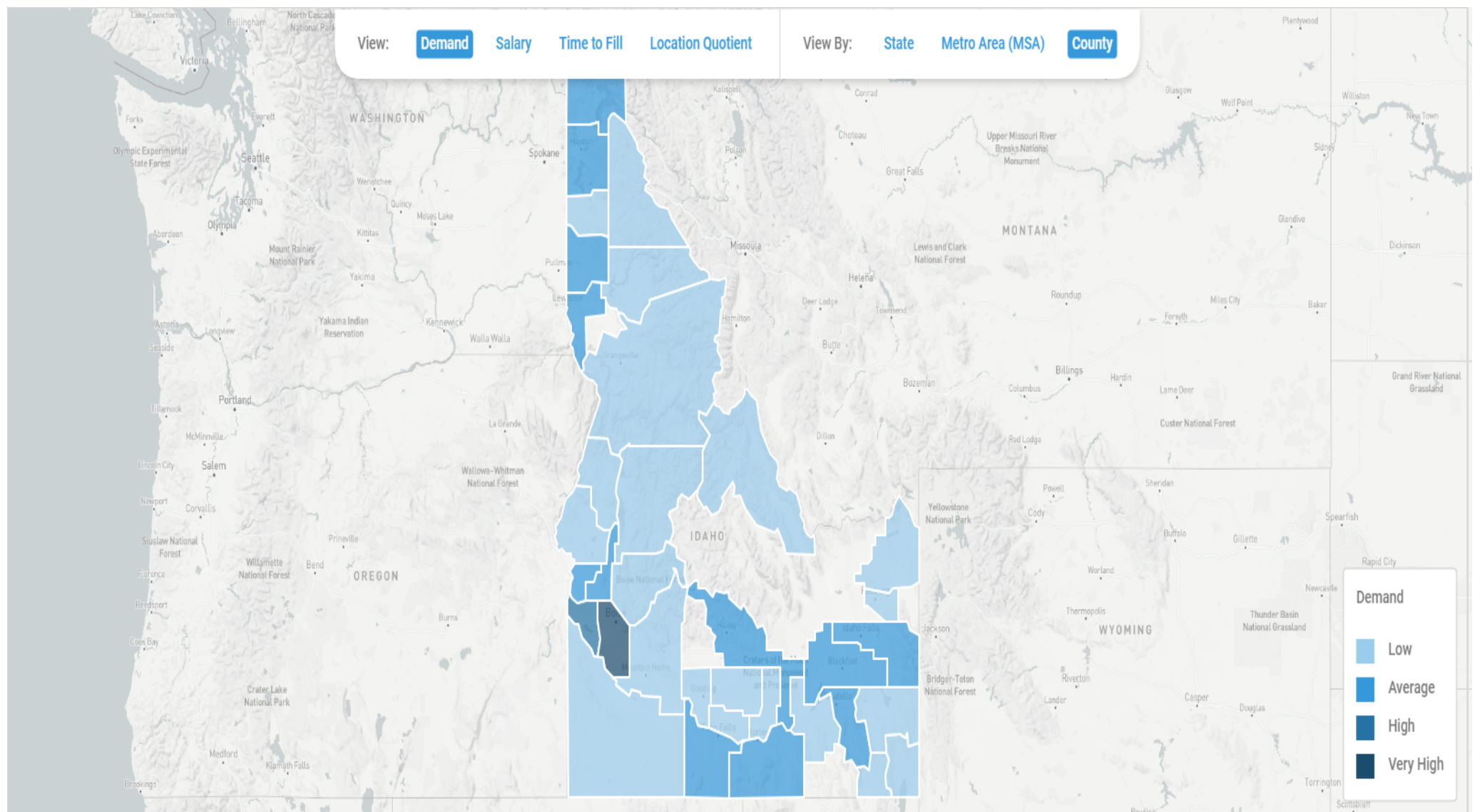

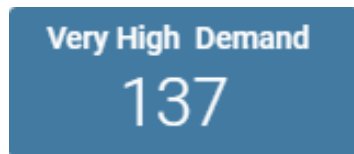

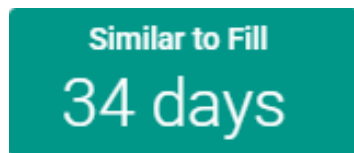


Projected Growth
