#### Launch Provider and Course Assessment



#### Goals:

- · Council retains decision making for use of WDTF
- · Matches employer identified skills to training
- Supports WDC strategies
- · Values existing state resources
- Uses limited staff efficiently

#### Scenario 1:

There is a skill identified in Launch with no training.

Yes, course presented to Policy Committee for decision.

Is training available through a public Idaho institution?

Yes, course presented to policy committee for decision.

No, Is course offered through an institution with an existing MOU?

No, is a course available on the Eligible Training Provider List?

Yes, Idaho WDC staff approaches provider about an MOU, and brings the course to Policy Committee for decision. No, WDC staff identifies potential training partners, approaches provider about a potential MOU, and brings the course to Policy Committee for decision.

### Scenario 2:

Private provider is requesting course added to Launch.

Is there a gap in training for the identified skill?

Yes, there are no comparable existing options for that skill offered either online or regionally. Idaho WDC staff approaches provider about a potential MOU, and brings the course to Policy Committee for decision.

No, the skill has existing matching courses. The provider can be referred to the Eligible Training Provider application for future opportunities.



# Scenario 3:

Training has been identified that algins with both Idaho Launch skills and WDC strategic plan.

Idaho WDC staff approaches provider about a potential MOU, and brings the course to Policy Committee for decision.

## Scenario 4:

An Idaho public institution has a course that matches an existing Launch skill.

Course presented to policy committee for decision.
