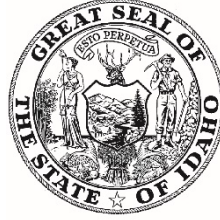

Virtual Care Model: The Virtual Care Model allows teams of providers to work together to provide high-quality and high-capacity care to our patients. Experienced bedside registered nurses work in a virtual capacity and provide direct patient care and mentorship to care partners.

NeST: The new Neuro, Surgical, Trauma ICU unit, opened to patients on February 28th. Saint Alphonsus is the only center that can support this level of care in the state; the unit contains 18 ICU rooms and 17 stepdown rooms (to support patients as they transition out of critical care). This unit features highly sophisticated equipment and technology for these patients and comforting, aesthetic environments for their family members.
