Idaho Apprenticeship Activities

Apprenticeship Idaho Partners

- Federal numbers 239 sponsors
- Enrolled 1528 active
- 50 new prog sponsors
- 57 63 occupations
- ID awarded formula fund model grant supports integrated apprenticeship opportunities (373520)
- ROI calculator being beta tested.
- Apprenticeship spotlights coming
 - Registered apprenticeship sponsors
 - Workforce professionals available to speak with organizations.
- IBE apprenticeship
 - o 295 youth apprenticeships in the last 3 years
 - o 222 since last August
 - o 25% received financial support (\$750 each)
 - o 4100 short of 40k to apprentices
 - Just implemented on the job training 100 stipends at \$200 each
 - o 75 employers right now
- HVAC /Plumbing at High School level
 - Standards approved and aligned.
