Premier Technology INC	1/1/2024	12/31/2026	\$428,749.52	Premier Technology will expand training for welders and other skilled trades employees, with a focus on hand welding, flame cutting, TIG and ARC welding, and related technical roles. The company will hire 85 new employees and train 160 current employees.
Amped Pump & Controls LLC	1/1/2025	12/31/2026	\$48,000.00	Amped Pumped and Control will expand into Kootenai County and launch a Registered Apprenticeship Program in electrical systems, controls, and instrumentation. The company will train 16 new employees and retrain 8 current staff through classroom and on-the-job instruction.
Sorrento Lactalis	6/1/2025	5/31/2027	\$310,000.00	Sorrento Lactalis will invest \$36 million to modernize its Nampa facility, increasing production capacity and efficiency. The project will provide targeted training for 131 employees, including 12 new hires, in new technologies, production, maintenance, and quality assurance.
Bingham Healthcare	11/1/2025	10/31/2027	\$112,557.68	Bingham Memorial Hospital will implement a virtual reality training program to prepare clinical staff and new hires for pediatric readiness, patient transfers, and wait-time reduction. VR-based, scenario-driven training will serve 306 current employees and 87 new hires in key clinical roles.

The program will train 16 Medical Assistants and Licensed Practical Nurses to become certified Limited Capacity Radiologic Technicians.

Training will prepare 25 current employees and 6 new hires for technical and professional advancement in integrated building solutions.

The company will hire and train 120 new employees in advanced manufacturing equipment operation, quality assurance, and high-tech food production.
