- New WIOA Guidance TEGL 07-25 Discussion as a group
 - Have most of it covered, not identified specifics
 - Can incorporate more if needed
 - Hold off a week to publish
 - New guidance on pg. 3 & 6 – align to American's Talent Strategy
 - 88% of the combined plan is put together
 - Formatting takes the most time
 - TEGL alignment to pillars goes into the combined only
 - Idaho is positively viewed by administration
 - Perkins will come in during next cycle
 - VR & ICBVI and changes, some minimal
 - We have spoken to individuals with barriers correctly

All

- ICBVI – have strategies that reference Hispanic community, need to address will likely get called out – modify priority and broaden
- If a section is part of statute, it should remain for the program
- Combined has 18 references to Hispanic mostly in Agriculture
- Executive orders do not negate Federal Law
- Agreement to utilize next week to finish and adjust as needed. Public comment is 30 days
- Submit extension request
- Post for public comment on Feb 9, minor tweaks can still be done
